







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














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



For more confident readers who can read simple stories.

- For children who can confidently read texts with a wider vocabulary and are beginning to read longer stories by themselves
 - 16 x 48pp fiction and non-fiction titles
- Key vocabulary is still repeated but the syntax is more complex and naturalsounding with a greater range of vocabulary






Notes for grown-ups

Read It Yourself is a series of modern stories, traditional tales and first reference books, written in a simple way for children who are learning to read. The books can be read independently or used for reading sessions at school.

The books in the **Beginner Reader** level closely follow the order that children will be taught phonics in school. This helps to build reading confidence and reinforces school learning in a fun way.

Each Beginner Reader book focuses on a set of graphemes (letters) and phonemes (sounds). The books also provide practice of common tricky words, such as 'the' and 'said', that cannot be sounded out.


Beginner Reader Level 0: Step 12 Ideas for use

- Help the child identify and sound out the phonemes (sounds) in the words they meet in the book. Then, blend these sounds together to read the words.
- Children learn best when reading is a fun experience.
 Read the book together, and give the child plenty of praise and encouragement.
- Read the book together more than once and talk about the story words and tricky words at the end of each reading to reinforce learning.
